### **Junior Representative Program – Information Pack 2025/2026**

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Dubbo Touch Junior representative program has experienced significant growth and success in recent years. It is a professional program that offers players the opportunity to compete at higher levels in a competitive and supportive environment. While the program requires a strong commitment from players, parents, coaches and managers, it aims to promote enjoyment, growth and skill development in the sport of touch football.

#### **PLAYER COMMITMENTS**

All players selected on the Dubbo Touch representative teams are expected to:

- Attended all scheduled training sessions
- Be available for mandatory tournaments
- Abide by the Code of Conduct and Representative Player and Selection Policy
- Meet all financial obligations by the require deadlines

Parents must review this pack carefully and ensure their child can meet these commitments prior to registering. If any issues arise, they should be discussed promptly with the Rep Coordinator as failure to do so may jeopardise your position in the team.

#### **PLAYER REGISTRATION PROCESS**

To register for the 2025/2026 Dubbo Touch Junior Representative Program:

1. Read and understand all information contained in this pack.
2. Agree to comply with the Code of Conduct and Representative Player and Selection Policy
3. Complete the online EOI form by Friday, 27 June 2025.

Note: Failure to complete the registration process above will result in ineligibility to trial.

## ELIGIBILITY

All players must be registered or intend to register in the 2025/2026 Dubbo Touch competitions (Junior, Women's and Winter or Summer Mixed or Men's).

**Note:** Players must be registered in a team or will forfeit their spot in the rep team. An individual registration does not ensure you will be placed in a junior team and be eligible for rep, as not all individuals can be guaranteed a team. It is recommended to register in a junior competition team.

## OFFICAL COMMUNICATION PLATFORM

All communication between coaches/managers and parents will be issued exclusively via the 'Stack Team App'. Parents of players selected must download Stack Team App, search 'Dubbo Touch Rep' and request to become a member of their child's team. Players who are 14 years and older can request to join their team Stack Team App chat but must also have a parent who is a member.

Players selected are required to attend all mandatory tournaments unless an exemption is sort for extenuating circumstances.

**Optional Carnivals:** Coaches may consider attending additional tournaments pending player availability. Where this is the case additional costs are likely to apply.

**Note - Under 8s:** A standalone U8's division doesn't exist. U8 rep teams are required to play up in the U10 division, which is a significant step up and, in some cases, results in games being one sided. Dubbo Touch is committed to our U8 rep program and sees strong benefits in players commencing basic rep skills development at a younger age, given significant improvements achieved by our U10's teams who both finished 13<sup>th</sup> at the 2024 NSW Touch Junior State Cup and then in the top 3 in 2025.

The Dubbo Touch Rep Player and Selection Policy available on at [www.dubbotouch.com](http://www.dubbotouch.com), outlines the trials/selection process, [www.dubbotouch.com](http://www.dubbotouch.com). Key points to note:

- Where two selections are being held players must attend a minimum of 1 selection trial.
- Players unable to attend, must submit complete the 'Inability to Trial' form available at [www.dubbotouch.com](http://www.dubbotouch.com) providing a written explanation before the trial in order to be considered for selection.
- Player's must wear a numbered playing singlet or shirt during the trial e.g. 2024 junior competition playing singlet. No rep singlets or shirts are permitted.
- Parents will not be permitted to observe trials (except U8s). Parents will drop players off 10 minutes prior to their start time. Players will report to the clubhouse to sign on. Parents to collect their child at the conclusion of the trials.
- Coaches may select squads (up to 16 players), who will train and play in each lead in tournament. Coaches will rotate players, to name 14 players for each game. A final team of 14 players will be selected in January for the NSW Touch Junior State Cup. All players must attend training, be available for tournaments, purchase uniform and play the applicable fees.
- Shadow players should attend training and be prepared for inclusion should an opportunity present. Shadow players are not required to pay rep levy or purchase uniform unless called into the team.

Final squads/teams will be announced via email. Parents will be required to accept or decline their child's position in the representative team by Monday 23 August 2025.

## TRAINING EXPECTATIONS

Training attendance is mandatory, with a minimum 75% attendance required. Attendance is critical to team preparation. In general teams will train 2 sessions per week from September to January and coaches may introduce a 3<sup>rd</sup> training per week in February. Training dates and times have been set by coaches.

The Rep Player Levy includes referee/coach payments and accommodation, training equipment, coaching courses, presentation etc. Due to extensive fundraising efforts with the 2025 NSW Touch Junior State Cup canteen, Dubbo Touch has significantly subsidised the rep player levy in 2025/2026.

### NSW TOUCH JUNIOR STATE CUP

Dubbo Touch is again hosting this major event, with the canteen significantly subsidising the rep program (approximately \$40,000). All families must volunteer to complete canteen shifts across the weekend. Non-compliance will result in loss of levy subsidy the following year.

**Note:** If NSW Touch Junior State Cup was not held in Dubbo, the levy would increase significantly to cover approximately \$10,000 in referee and coach accommodation.

### REP PLAYER REFEREE PROGRAM

Dubbo Touch encourages representative players to complete the 'Affiliate' referee course and become qualified referees.

Badged referees are paid:

- Junior Competition: \$10 per game
- Senior Competition: \$15 per game

Referees will be mentored by the Referee Directors. This initiative support player development and deepens their understanding of the game and rules.
