

Dubbo Touch Association – Expression of Interest

Aboriginal Artwork Design for Representative Uniforms

Dubbo Touch would like to demonstrate respect to our First Nations people and their long term involvement with Dubbo Touch at both the local and representative level, by incorporating an Aboriginal design into our Dubbo Devils representative Touch uniform.

We invite people from the Aboriginal community to submit an artwork, which complies with design criteria below by Friday, 31 July 2020.

- 1. Design requirements;
 - a) The design is to tell a story about the Dubbo Touch community and be inclusive of Men, Women and Youth
 - b) All designs must be authentic and original work of the artist submitting the design and must not infringe on the rights of any other party. The submitting artist must be the sole owner of the copyright in the submitted design and indemnifies the Dubbo Touch Association in relation to any claims made by third parties regarding the submitted design. Should there be a dispute in relation to the copyright in the submitted design, the Dubbo Touch Association reserves the right to request further information from the artist to determine copyright ownership
 - c) The design shall remain the property of Dubbo Touch indefinitely and can be used at the discretion of the Dubbo Touch committee across all senior and junior representative uniforms
 - d) In your design please consider artwork will be used on representative uniform items such as playing shirts and singlets, coaches, managers and supporter shirts, playing shorts, training gear, caps and tracksuits etc. as determined by the Dubbo Touch committee
 - e) The design is to take up to approx. 30% of the uniform item
 - f) The current Dubbo Touch hand print logo is to remain on the players shirts and singlets on the front top left hand side
 - g) The Touch Football Australia (TFA) logo is to placed on the players shirts and singlets on the front top right hand side
 - h) Numbers in accordance with TFA guidelines ie. size and type are to be placed on the back of the players shirts and singlets
 - i) The Dubbo Touch Association colours of 'Navy Blue and Maroon' are to be maintained on the remaining 70% of the uniform item
 - j) Artwork must be submitted in high resolution PDF or eps file suitable for reproduction by the uniform supplier the designs received
- 2. Selection process;
 - a) A panel of representatives from the Dubbo Touch Community (consisting of two committee members (one senior and one junior), one senior player, 1 junior player and

an independent person not associated with the club will review all submissions and narrow down to two designs, to go to electronic vote for the winner by the Dubbo Touch community

- b) A sum of \$1,000 will be awarded to the winning artist as well as a printed representative shirt or singlet with the winning design
- c) The successful artist will be notified by phone and email, and will be announced on the Dubbo Touch Association website and Facebook page
- 3. Assuming all design requirements are met, the winning design will be assessed with priority given to the following criteria in the order listed;
 - 1. Traditional owner
 - 2. Aboriginal person in touch community
 - 3. Aesthetic appeal of the design and relevance of the story to the Dubbo Touch community
