



## Dubbo Touch Junior Rego Pack 2020

The Dubbo Touch Association will be offering Junior touch competitions from August to December 2020. In keeping with the NSW Touch COVID return to play policies we have made changes to the way we will conduct the Junior Competition. - Divisions U7, U9, U11, U13, U15 - mixed, boys and girls teams welcome but will play each other where possible teams will be graded. No stand-alone competitions for each.
- Cost \$70 per player includes a playing singlet, you will be asked to add this to your registration.

Online registrations for the 2020 Junior Competition will be open from

**13th JULY 20 20 UNTIL 14<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2020 – 5PM**

- Team registrations closed August 7
- Individual registrations close August 14The competitions commencing on **Monday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 with grand finals held on 14<sup>th</sup> December.** (Please see Competition Calendar attached).
- To register individuals will need to be invited by a team manager. If you are not associated with a team you need to contact Vickie Everingham (Registrar) at [juniors@dubbotouch.com](mailto:juniors@dubbotouch.com).

The registration process is the responsibility of the **team manager & the individual** that will be participating in the competition. Before the participant has completed the rego process they will need to create a NRL account. This is a unique username and password, please retain this for future registrations. (a guide to the online process is below).

DTA requires that each junior team has a designated **Manager who is responsible for organising the team including** communicating game times and field allocations, undertaking subbing and having a basic understanding of the rules of Touch Football to provide guidance to the team.

If the person who is registering the team is the Manager, they will then receive a conformation email – you are then asked to add information to your profile including your WWCC number. If the Manager is not the person registering the team they are to create a NRL account and register as a *Coach, Trainer or Volunteer* and must supply your WWCC number.

All Under 7 and Under 9 teams require a delegated person (this can be but doesn't have to be the team manager) **to assist on the field by acting as the coach and referee** for their team for each game e.g. in defence having players get onside, counting touches etc. (more touch football rules and coaching tips can be found on the DTA website <https://www.dubbotouch.com/news>)

Late registrations will only be considered via an individual written request outlining the reasons why you did not register before the deadline or in replacement of an already registered team member.

Only legitimate reasons will be accepted. **Unacceptable** reasons include;

- No Computer – Use a friend's or you can visit the Dubbo Library
- No Access to internet - As above
- No Email - Please use a next of kin's email
- Didn't have time - Not acceptable

### REMINDERS

- **DUBBO TOUCH ASSOCIATION WILL BE SUPPLYING ALL PLAYING SINGLETS.** When registering you will be asked for a shirt size, please be accurate as this is the size you will receive and there will not be an opportunity to swap with DTA only amongst others that have ordered the wrong size.
- U7 and U9 teams are required to have a maximum of 8 players.
- U11 to U15 teams are required to have a minimum of 10 players and a maximum of 12 players.
- **Swapping of shirts throughout the game is not permitted.**

### DUTY TEAM REQUIREMENTS

All teams must meet the duty requirements for the competition which includes each week providing an individual willing to referee and/ or score. (one person per team)

- The individual doing duty can be a player or parent from the team.
- Individuals who will be doing duty must report to the clubhouse at least 5 minutes prior to the game to be ticked off as attending and to collect the scoreboard.
- Duty referees are required to wear a referee shirt if badged or otherwise an alternative shirt to be easily identifiable. There are duty referee singlet available at the clubhouse.
- A failure to comply with the duty requirements will see teams lose 3 competition points. Dubbo Touch will endeavour to provide badge referees to assist duty team referees where possible however this is not guaranteed and individuals should be prepared to referee.
- Prior to registering please ensure you have individual/s willing to referee. **(PLEASE BYO WHISTLE).**

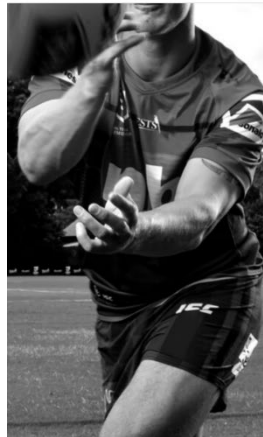
4. Enter in team details – remember team shirts will be supplies for Juniors.

5. You will then receive a confirmation email – you are then asked to add information to your profile including your WWCC number.

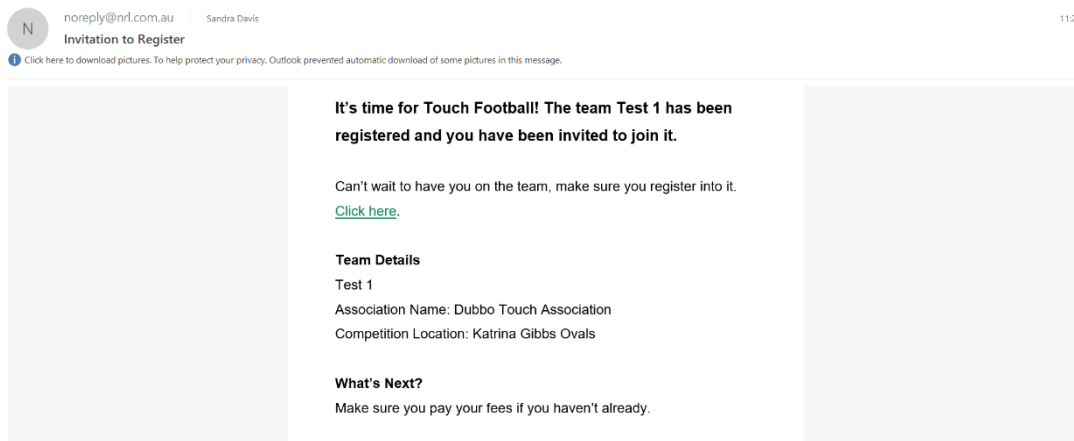

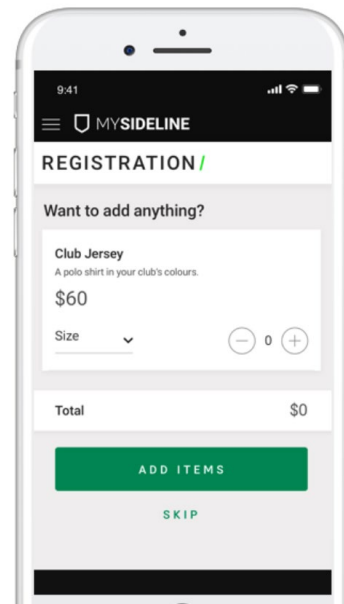
6. Your players will receive the following email – this will take them through the player registration
