

The Dubbo Touch Association will be offering Senior Mixed and Men's summer touch competitions from October 2020 to March 2021. In keeping with the NSW Touch COVID return to play policies we have made changes to the way we will conduct the Senior Competition. Online registrations for the 2020 Senior Summer Competition will be open from

17TH AUGUST 20 UNTIL 2ND OCTOBER 2020 – 5PM

- Team registrations close on 25th September 2020
- Individual registrations close on 2nd October 2020
- The Mixed competition commences on **Monday 12th October 2020.** (Please see Competition Calendar attached).
- The Men's competition commences on **Wednesday 14**th **October 2020**. (Please see Competition Calendar attached).
- To register individuals will need to be invited by a team manager. If you are not associated with a team you need to contact Ashlie Pascoe (Registrar) at registrar@dubbotouch.com.

The registration process is the responsibility of the **team manager & the individual** that will be participating in the competition. Before the participant has completed the rego process they will need to create an NRL account. This is a unique username and password, please retain this for future registrations. (a guide to the online process is below).

DTA requires that each senior team has a designated **Manager who is responsible for organising the team including** communicating game times and field allocations, undertaking subbing and having a basic understanding of the rules of Touch Football to provide guidance to the team.

Late registrations will only be considered via an individual written request to the Competition Director outlining the reasons why you did not register before the deadline or in replacement of an already registered team member.

Only legitimate reasons will be accepted. Unacceptable reasons include;

- No Computer Use a friend's or you can visit the Dubbo Library
- No Access to internet As above
- No Email Please use a next of kin's email
- Didn't have time Not acceptable

REMINDERS

- Teams need a minimum of **12 players** to qualify for competition
- Uniforms with a number of the back for each player must be worn. After round 3 anyone not in uniform will not be able to take the field

DUTY TEAM REQUIREMENTS

All teams must meet the duty requirements for the competition which includes providing two individual willing to referee and/ or score each week.

- Individuals who will be doing duty must report to the clubhouse at least 5 minutes prior to the game to be ticked off as attending and to collect the scoreboard.
- Duty referees are required to wear a referee shirt if badged or otherwise an alternative shirt to be easily identifiable.



 A failure to comply with the duty requirements will see teams lose 3 competition points. Dubbo Touch will endeavour to provide badge referees

to assist duty team referees where possible however this is not guaranteed and individuals should be prepared to referee.

 Prior to registering please ensure you have individual/s willing to referee. (PLEASE BYO WHISTLE).

1. NSW touch is using My Sideline as the base for all registration details for Touch comps. Click on the following link and go to Register – top right hand









2. Once you have opened the Register page you will be given 4 options.



3. For TEAM REGISTRATION Find the Dubbo competition you wish to enter




 You will need to create a NRL account to proceed - this is a simple process and it will give you the option to create a NRL account.






4. Enter in team details.
